- Eleanor's Coin Collection, different images on the coins
- Walking in Scotland...
- Scottish Money: 3 Banks – RBS, BOS, Clydesdale, different faces/images on the notes
- BOS: Sir Walter Scott £5 Brig o'Doon £10 Glenfinnan Viaduct £20 Forth Bridge
- RBS: Women £5 Author Nan Shepherd 2 fishes Scientist Mary Summerville 2 otters
- Clydesdale: £5 Sir William Arrol and the Forth Bridge £10 Robert Burns Old and New towns of Edinburgh
- Euro's feature stylised bridges –presumably about European unity
- British new notes: £5 and £10, Winston & Jane Austen
- Jesus story in the Gospel. The Pharisees trying to catch him out with a trick question
- Gaelic attitude to possessions: no word for *owning* - instead Gaelic talks about *being with*, it's a gift
- All we have, even life itself, is God's gift to us.
- God's generosity to us in Jesus
- Stewardship: John Wesley said, 'The last part of a man to be converted is his wallet.'
